# Learning and Development in Children With Cerebral Palsy

The Psychology Club invites you to a talk by Dr. Louise Bottcher, Ph.D. about her innovative research on learning and development in children with cerebral palsy. Dr. Botcher works at the University of Copenhagen and is currently a visiting scholar at the CUNY Graduate Center. Her research looks into the cognitive impairment of children with cerebral palsy (CP), a condition caused by a prenatal or otherwise very early lesion to the brain. The aim of her research is to understand the problems children with CP experience with development and learning from a dialectical perspective, which connects developmental neuro-psychology with cultural-historical perspectives on development and learning.
